Sermon Outline:

- I. Illustration Pete's friend from college: slowly coming to Christ.
- II. Taking time/process. But with regards to missions, things happen fast!
- III. Seeing through God's eyes not seeing through earthly eyes.
- IV. God does 99.9% of the work; He invites us to do our little part through mission!

Sermon Summary:

- 1. What words or phrases from this scripture passage resonated in you as you read them? Why?

 - How did your family of origin do sharing good news with others? How do you think your family of origin shapes the way you share good news with others?
