Jesus Heals Ten Men With Leprosy

11 Now on his way to Jerusalem, Jesus traveled along the border between Samaria and Galilee. 12 As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy[a] met him. They stood at a distance 13 and called out in a loud voice, “Jesus, Master, have pity on us!”

14 When he saw them, he said, “Go, show yourselves to the priests.” And as they went, they were cleansed.

15 One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back, praising God in a loud voice. 16 He threw himself at Jesus’ feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan.

17 Jesus asked, “Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? 18 Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?” 19 Then he said to him, “Rise and go; your faith has made you well.”

1. Read Luke 17:11-19

3. Have you experienced being healed as you walked something out (not immediately) like the lepers who were healed as they walked? What was that experience like for you?
4. Respond to the prompts that were shared with the church:
 - This year, I’m grateful to God for...
 - God has been at work in my life my life through...
 - I’m grateful for New Life Fellowship because...
5. What testimonies that you heard during the service inspired you the most?
6. Take time to pray for the areas in your life where you are experiencing pain: physical, emotional and/or spiritual. Like the lepers, you can expect Jesus to hear and respond to your cries.
